

## 2021: the need

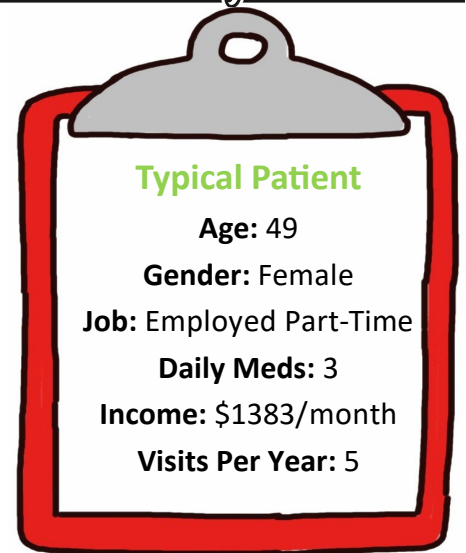
Thousands of people without access to insurance have received care from the Community Clinic of Southwest Missouri.
